Objectives:

1. To make students aware of causes and effects of AIDS.
2. To explain the students about necessary precautions to be taken against AIDS.
3. To spread awareness in society about seriousness of the disease and effective measures that can be taken.
4. To make students aware about the evil effects of tobacco consumption and smoking on public health.
5. To explain the ill-effects of tobacco that leads to various health hazards among adults including oral and throat cancer.

Highlights:

1. Ms. Akanksha Verma(JCI member) welcomed and introduced the speakers of the program.
2. Dr. Pravin Joshi made an introductory remark on specialization of all the speakers.
3. Dr. Mukta Motwani explained about how AIDS seriously affect the immune system and causes life threatening infections or conditions including malignancies.
4. She also illustrated that the body fluids like blood, semen, vaginal fluid, breast milk acts as a medium through which HIV spreads.
5. She pointed out the serious impact of HIV and AIDS through the survey report.
6. Dr. R. S. Madan explained that use of tobacco most commonly leads to diseases affecting the heart, liver and lungs.
7. She described that tobacco consumption causes cancer, heart disease, stroke, lung diseases, diabetes, and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, which includes emphysema and chronic bronchitis.
8. Dr. Karandeep Madan illustrated that smoking increases risks of tuberculosis, certain eye diseases, and problems of the immune system, including rheumatoid arthritis.

9. At the end, Dr. Manjiri Pathak proposed a vote of thanks and concluded the session.

Outcomes:

1. Students gained information on serious hazards of AIDS and how one can prevent oneself from getting infected.
2. They also understood what precautions can be taken against AIDS.
3. Students learnt about all evil effects caused due to AIDS and different ways of HIV transmission.
4. Students realised the harmful effects of tobacco consumption.
5. Students also learnt about the related diseases causes due to smoking/tobacco.
6. Students have learnt that if non smoker comes in contact with the smoker they will also be badly affected.
7. Students have learnt that they should use smoking zone if at all they want to smoke.
8. Students also gained information about the substitutes for smoking that are free of tobacco.
